

ROYAL YACHT SQUADRON INTERNATIONAL BICENTENARY REGATTA

Notes of clarification on the International Regatta IRC Event

- 1. With the exception of the J Class, all yachts not in the team racing (J70s GNOR Annex A), or Level Rating (First 40s GNOR Annex B) groups of the regatta shall race under IRC handicaps, whether they are modern or classic yachts. This includes the Race Around the Island (GNOR Annex D).
- 2. Crew classifications for all IRC yachts whether involved in the team trophies or not are as indicated in GNOR Annex C, paragraph3.
- 3. All yachts **included in the IRC team trophies** shall be "modern", i.e. not classic yachts or J Class.
- 4. For the avoidance of doubt, modern and classic yachts will sail in different divisions, the exact split for which will be detailed in the Sailing Instructions, or earlier if the total number of yachts entered in each category is known before the SIs are published.
- 5. There is no limit to the number of yachts a club may enter, unless the regatta is oversubscribed. If so the OA retains the right to refuse entry.
